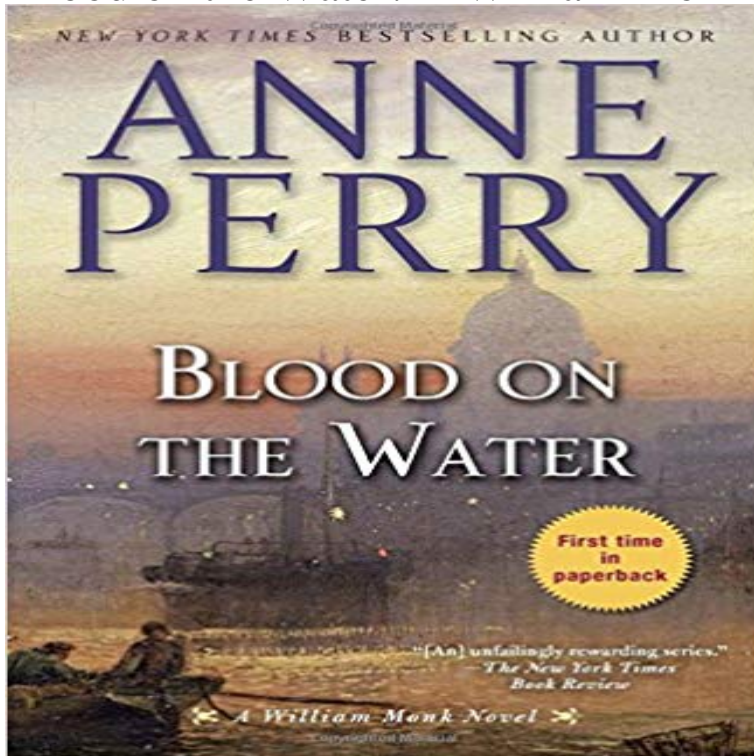


Blood on the Water: A William Monk Novel

Backed up by his astute wife, Hester, and his old reliable friend Oliver Rathbone, Monk vows to find answers but instead finds himself treading the dangerous waters of international intrigue, his questions politely turned aside by a formidable array of the powerful and privileged.
