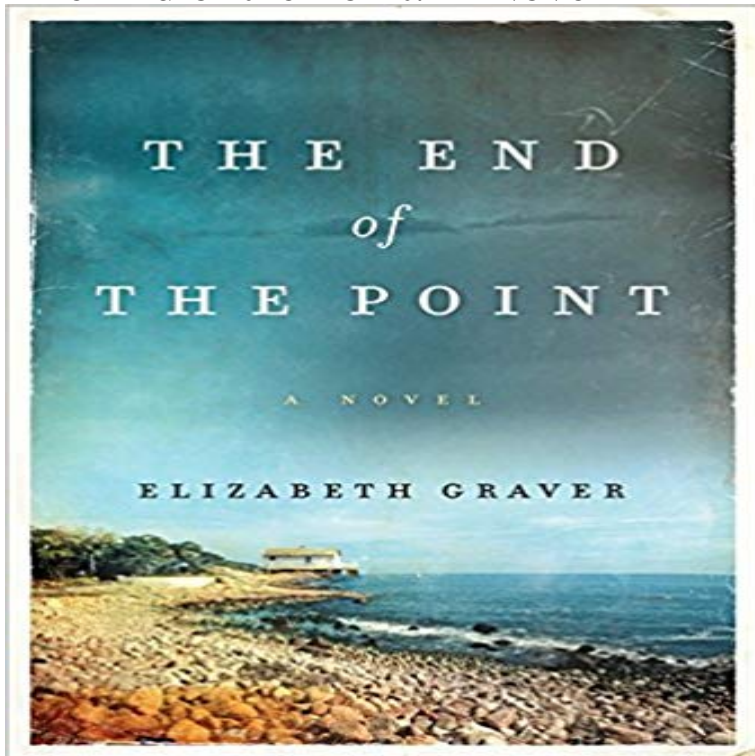


The End of the Point: A Novel
