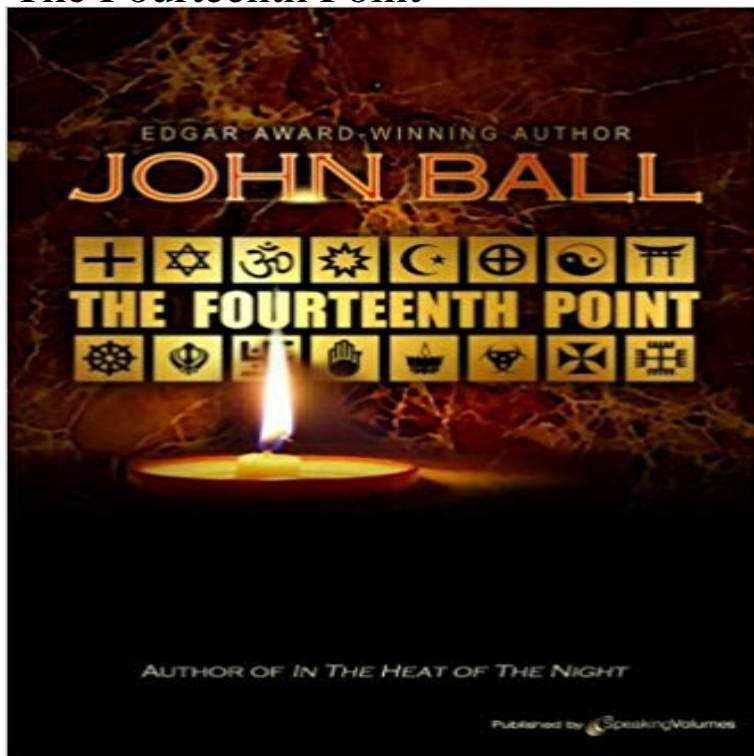


The Fourteenth Point
