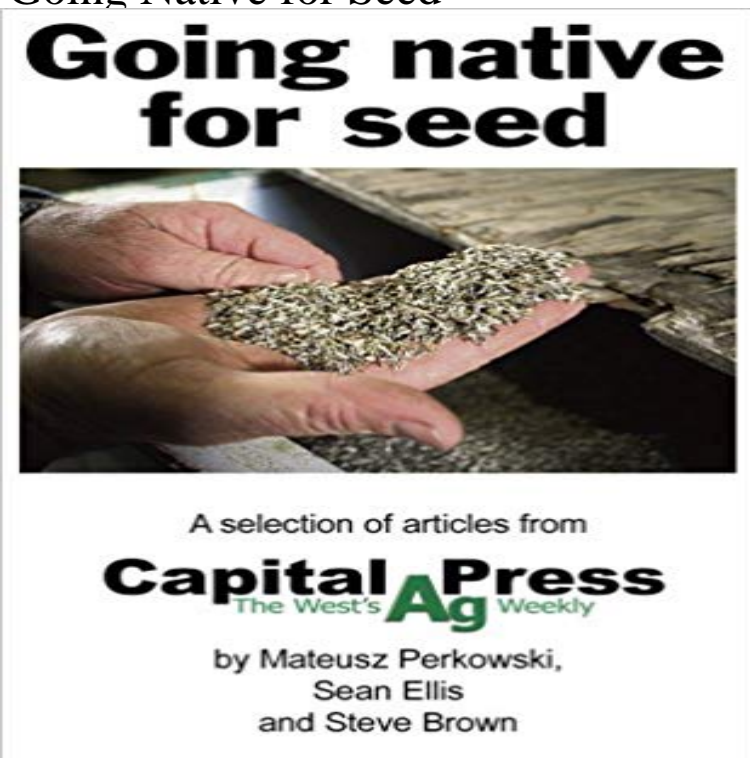


Going Native for Seed
