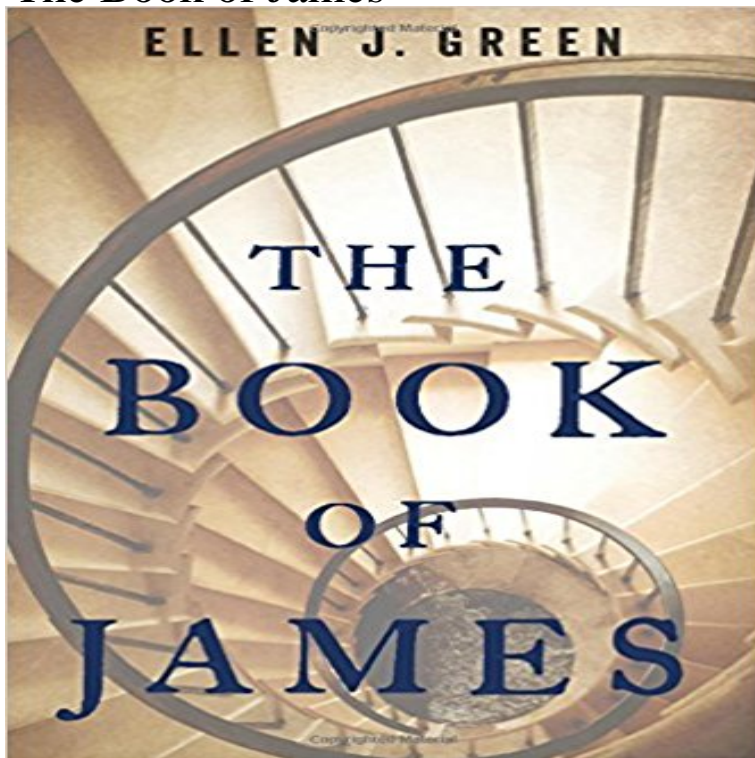


## The Book of James
