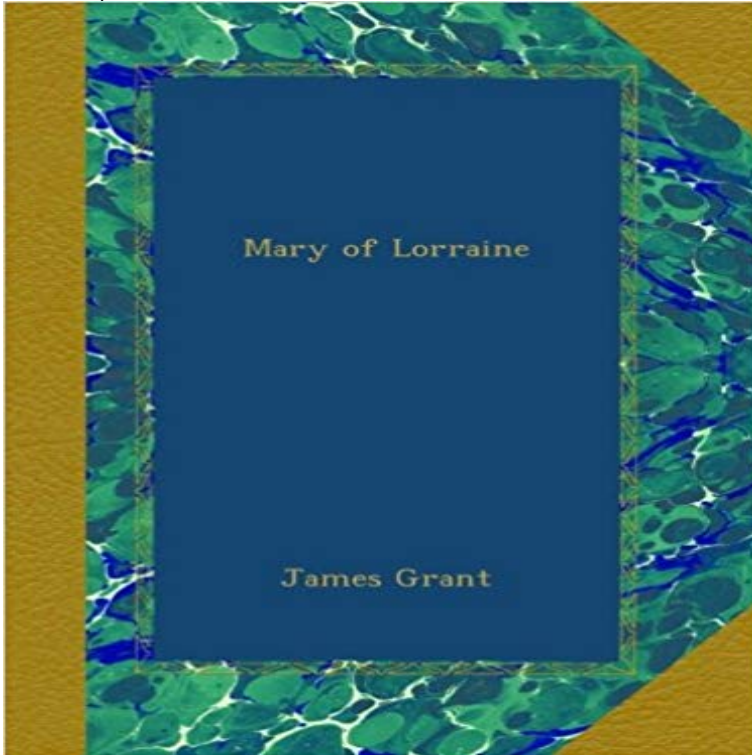


Mary of Lorraine
