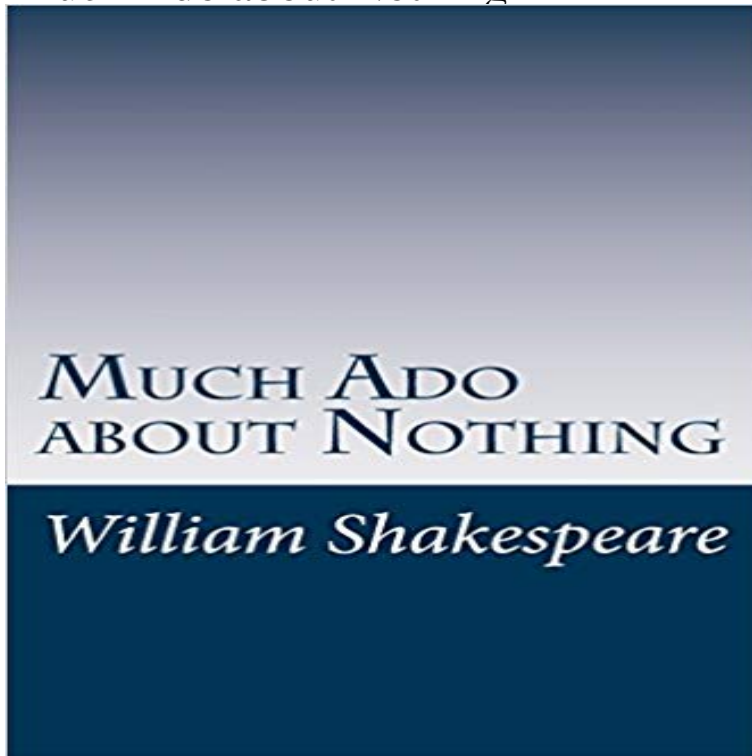


## Much Ado about Nothing
