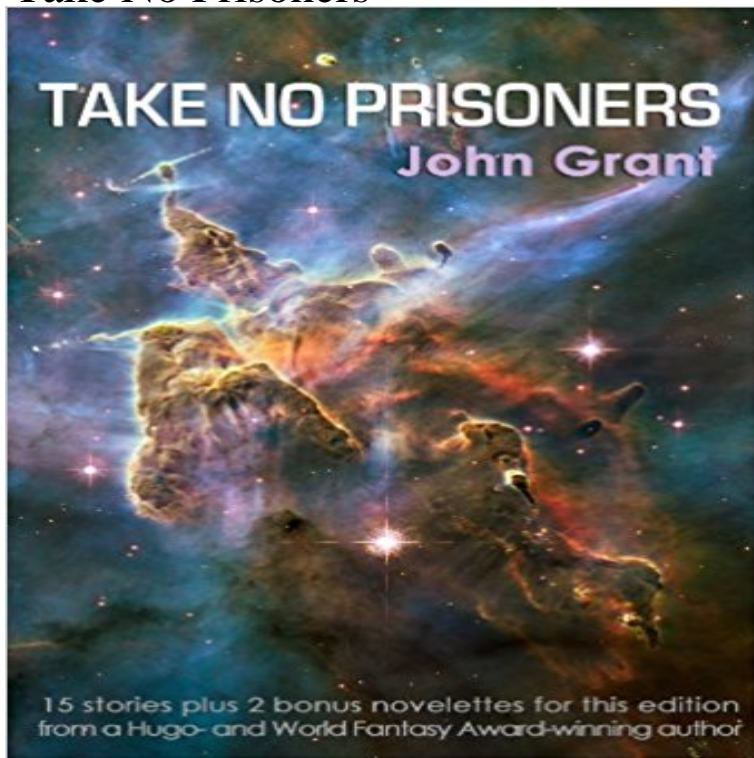


Take No Prisoners
