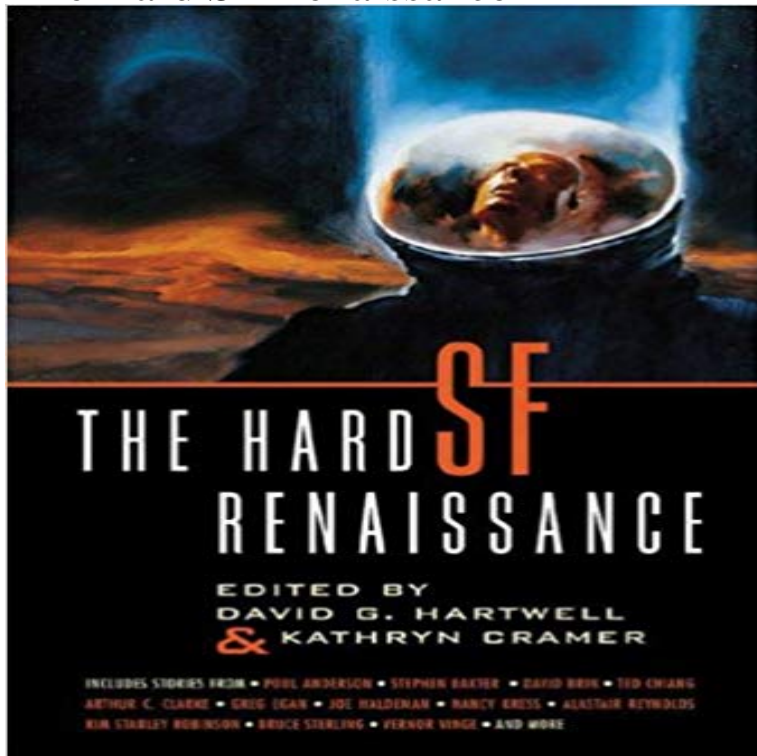


The Hard SF Renaissance
