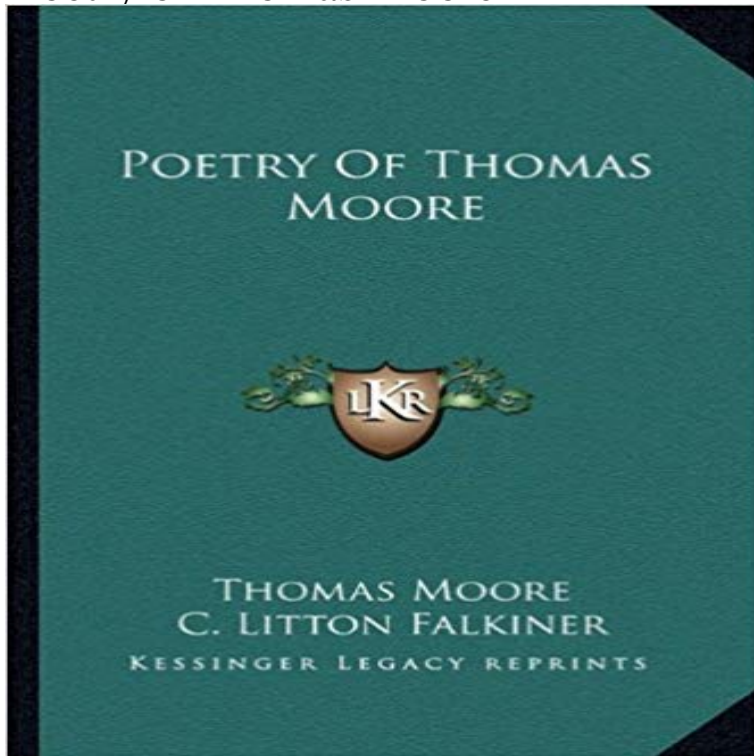


Poetry of Thomas Moore
