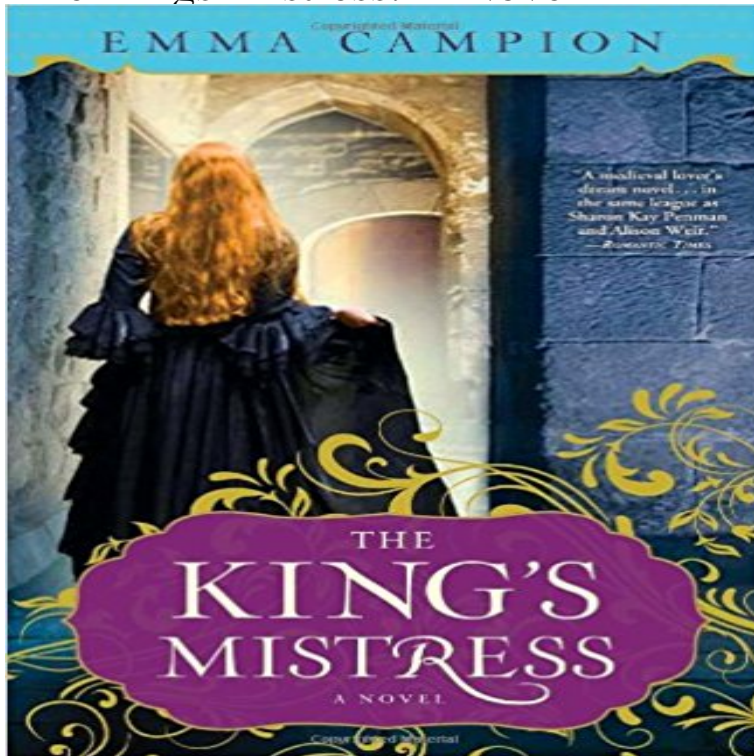


The Kings Mistress: A Novel
