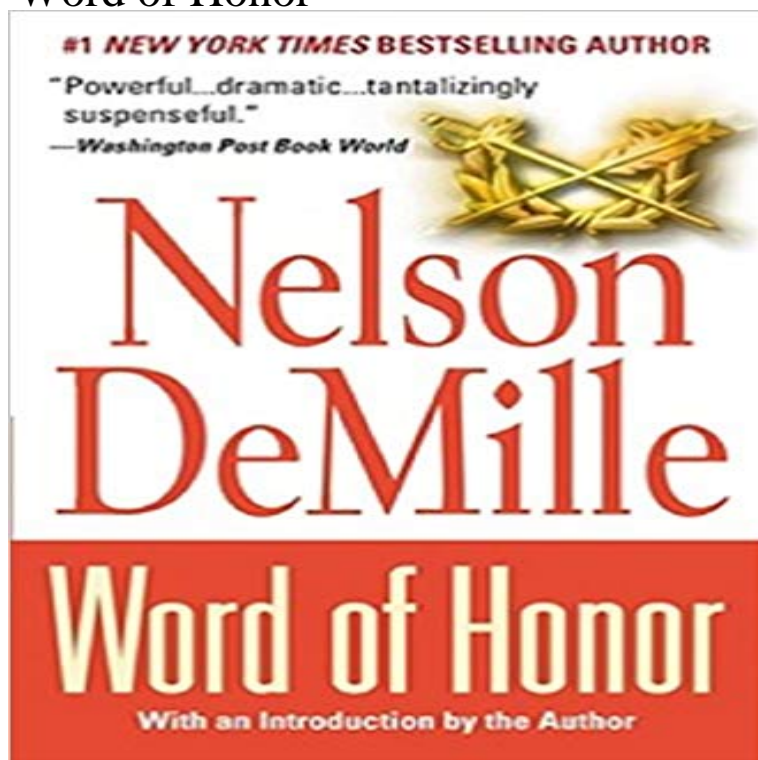


# Word of Honor
